Requirements to enroll at A-B Tech and options for students who don't have a high school diploma or GED/high school equivalency

Basic Admissions Requirements

In order to take **curriculum** classes (for college credit) at A-B Tech, you must either have a high school diploma/GED *or* be at least 18 years old. If you're 18 or older and do not have a high school diploma or GED, you are encouraged to contact our Career Services department at careerservices@abtech.edu to discuss your options.

There is no minimum high school or prior college GPA required to enroll. There may be additional enrollment steps for non-US citizens.

Most **Continuing Education** classes do not require you to have a high school diploma or GED. Students under 18 cannot register for Continuing Education classes online. Continuing Education students must be at least 16 by the time a class starts in order to register for a class. Students who are 16 and 17 years old must have a minor permission form on file to register for Continuing Education classes.

Selective and Limited Programs

Having a high school degree or GED is a requirement for some of our Selective and Limited Programs at A-B Tech. Refer to the application criteria packets for the individual programs on the [Selective and Limited Programs](#) page for details.

Dual-Enrollment for High School Students
